

Please state that you are with the "Studebaker Car Club" to receive this discounted price. Hotel guests will receive a complimentary breakfast and in-room internet access. (after Sept. 17th, rooms are available on an "as available" basis). Dry RV parking is \$25 night.







Dryer Sheets and Studebakers

I have been told that dryer sheets placed in and around your car can keep small

vermin out! When I bought my first Studebaker truck, it had been left outside in a field for years. The interior had been redone, move in ready, for the rats. They must have occupied that cab for years, as the amount of droppings removed could be measured in buckets.

So I was highly motivated to find an effective way to keep them out in the future. I have been using dryer sheets not only in cars that get driven less frequently, but also in my camper, with good results. I have never seen evidence of vermin, but I'm a city dweller and could have an advantage.



Place them in the trunk, under the hood as well as the cab of the vehicle. Think about all the small accesses vermin might use to gain entrance. The brake and clutch pedals as they exit the floor pan, throttle linkage through the fire wall, master cylinder cover plate. In the trunk, there is the hole at the bottom of the spare tire well, just to mention a few, and place the sheets near these areas.
