



Early last moth we had our meeting hosted by Mel France at his new museum




at his home in Yuba City. Wow! Mel has collected an astounding collection of automotive memorabilia, rare parts, automotive service tools and equipment, and so much more!

Motorists are showing an increasing awareness in the value of seat belts in preventing serious injuries and death to the extent that this awareness is being carried over to the legislative bodies of many states and in some instances legislation has already been passed making front seat belts compulsory.

Studebaker, as a leader in the effort to promote safety, has already taken the initiative in regard to scat belts for the Avanti. As you know, this car presently is being produced with front seat belts, left and right, installed unless the order specifically states that seat belts are to be omitted.

Starting with shipments from the factory on March 1, 1963, front seat belts, left and right, will be furnished on all passenger cars unless we are specifically advised to omit. Passenger car orders received after March 1, 1963, will be supplied with front seat belts unless the order states "omit."
